## Interested in any education or training that can improve your chances of employment?

The Job Hub can apply for grants to the cost of £1500 to undertake accredited vocational training up to Level 3 (eligibility criteria may apply).

### What can I apply for?

We can apply for up to £1500 towards course fees (the course must be accredited vocational course up to Level 3) and/or **costs associated with studying**, including: child care, travel and mobility costs and accessible materials.

An example of some of courses that you can consider are:

- Child Care Level 2 or 3 courses
- SIA Training
- Community Interpreting

## Good news stories



**We always love to see clients succeeding in achieving their aims, whether that's starting a new job or moving into education or training. This month we'd especially like to share the success of a couple of our residents that our employment adviser Shazna supported them with:**

### Resident MM – Teaching Assistant

MM applied for this job herself. Our adviser helped MM with her CV as well as getting her some voluntary hours over at STCA youth club. One of the requirements for the job was that MM had to have some experience in working with children or young people. Shazna had identified that it would be appropriate to get her in with the youth club. MM was provided with some interview prep and as well as some confidence boosting tasks, so MM would feel confident in her work and approach to employers.

MM has been offered the job and is in the process of completing her DBS check.

### TR – Set up own business and Self-Employed

Our adviser Shazna has been supporting TR over several appointments and had helped him build his CV until discovering that he may be better off building his own business. Shazna has since helped write up a business plan, registered him up on Companies House and has registered him as being self-employed. We also established that he will still require some source of income, so have suggested setting him up as a Deliveroo, Uber Eats and Just Eat delivery driver (all on a bicycle) so that he could earn money on a flexible basis and still be classed as self-employed.

TR has taken this advice and has started working as a delivery driver in order to fund his business.
