'Our Little Markets CIC is proud to announce we will now be running the community café located on Ossulston Street.'



We're pleased to be working in partnership with STCA to ensure locals get a café THEY want.

Household Support Fund

Camden recently devolved the administration of the central government Household Support Fund, in place to combat severe hardship over last winter.

Peter, our Signposting & Referrals coordinator was tasked by Camden with making applications for the fund for clients of the Living Centre.

As of 15th March, **53 households** have been helped with funds and vouchers totalling **£7,950**. Most of these have been in St Pancras and Somers Town ward whilst others have been for clients of the Living Centre's various services.

Further applications are being processed as the fund closes on 31st March 2022.

What is it about?

Somers Town has received funding from the Mayor of London to become a more sustainable neighbourhood.


The goal is to help residents, local businesses and organisations understand how climate change is affecting them, and more importantly, to work together on activities that are good for the environment, their pockets and their quality of life.

Overview of the project

We will work on two areas. The production of a local long-term plan (the Neighbourhood Strategy to 2030) that identifies what needs to happen locally to become the neighbourhood we all want to live in. And the delivery of a number of projects to start working towards the improvements we all want to see.

Planning and making the projects happen will be done by working together with residents, local businesses and other organisations in our area.
