September: Niyan

'Making yogurt: When you have a lot of milk left and it's going to expire you can make it into yogurt. Just warm up the milk in a sauce pan, put it in a container and put a table spoon of natural yogurt for every litre of milk. Mix it thoroughly then cover it and put a kitchen towel ground it to maintain heat and leave for 4 - 5 hours in a warm place. Afterwards, put it into the fridge and it is ready to eat for the next day.'

October: Shanaz

'Make a shelf in the fridge that is eye level for everyone. Place the food that will expire very soon on that shelf and tuck away other food that has a longer fridge date. So those items do not go out of date and end up in the bin.'

November:

'To ensure that the food we have in our fridge is all consumed before restocking. To also buy only the essentials that we really need and not splurge on items that are not needed. Also to plan meals ahead of time to ensure we don't waste food.'

You decide the project, and the qualification is built around supporting your journey. Job Hub and Camden Participation team will ensure you have the support you need to focus on your project. Upon completing the course, you can apply for funding to implement your proposals and put your project forward for accreditation, resulting in a:
