We always love to see clients succeeding in achieving their aims, whether that's starting a new job or moving into education or training. This month we'd especially like to mention:

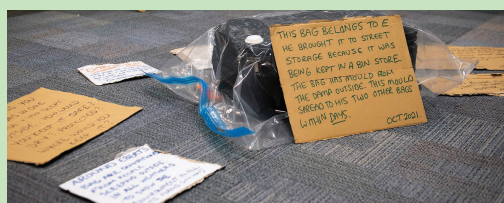
- A big well done to Vivian, who has changed career direction and recently started an apprenticeship in project management!
