**GREEN
DOCTOR**

During energy consultation, the Green Doctor will provide residents:

- Personalised advice on energy bills, for example, help to understand confusing/incorrect bills
- Personalised advice on air quality in your home and how to improve this
- Energy saving tips, encouraging behavioural change
- Information about the benefits of smart meters
- Delivering **free energy-saving** items such as draft proofing strips/LED light bulbs, etc
- Support accessing home improvement grants and schemes

And where they are eligible:

- Supporting with accessing the Water Discounts, Priority Services Register, and other schemes as well as information about Warm Homes Discount
- Support with applications for energy or water debt relief
- Refer residents to other services for additional support if needed

Benefits to having a Green Doctor appointment:

- Supports residents on how through behaviour change they can reduce their energy bills, whilst keeping warm in their home
- Gives resident confidence to take control of their energy bills
- Makes homes warmer and more energy efficient through practical interventions

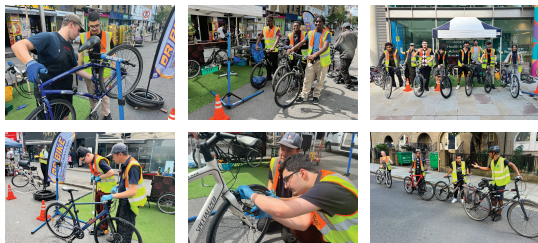

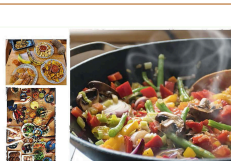

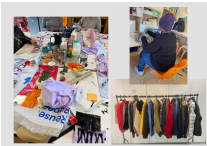
