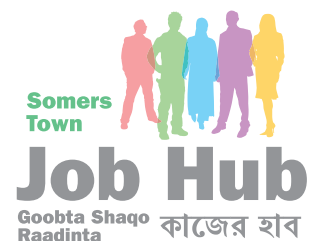
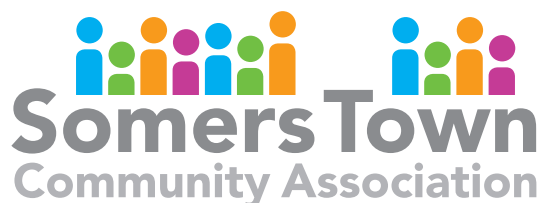
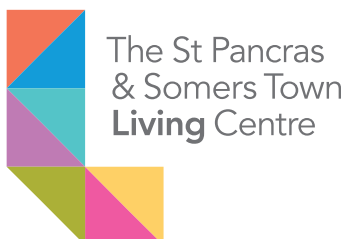


Somers Town Community Newsletter

Many Job Hub clients start by **volunteering** to build up their experience and skills; **building confidence** by taking part in a group or workshop; or undertaking **training** or **education** that will give them a **qualification** and chance to learn and grow.

We can also help you to **create or update your CV**, **find and apply for jobs**, and **practise for interviews**.

Feeling stuck with your job applications, or attending lots of interviews but not getting an offer? We can talk with you about why, and offer feedback and suggestions for how to get 'unstuck'.

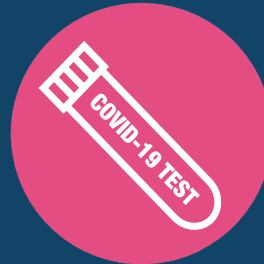
