Find out how this new community app for Somers Town can help you take simple actions to **save money and help the environment**.

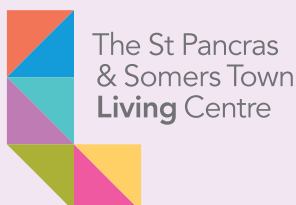
The Scone app is free, simple to use and will connect you with hundreds of residents in Somers Town who are taking action and sharing ideas on how to improve their quality of life.

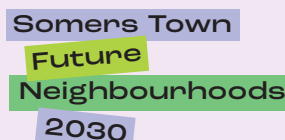
