- A dedicated employment adviser


- Advice on benefits, childcare, and other household-related issues

We always love to see clients succeeding in achieving their aims, whether that's starting a new job or moving into education or training. This month we'd especially like to mention what one of our residents that has been accessing the service has said about his time with us.

"I have been working with Faisal for over a year now. He is an exceptional person to work with when it comes to helping me with job applications. He has a genuine care for me when it comes to well being – this is rare from other job advisors".

During his time with the Job Hub, our advisers first worked with Mohammed to improve his CV. We identified and highlighted the key skills he already had and helped arrange them in a way that effectively showcased his strengths to potential employers.

Mohammed was provided with multiple mock interviews and supported in applying for jobs that aligned with his interests. As he describes himself as an introvert who prefers working alone and away from large crowds, his adviser carefully considered this when identifying suitable job opportunities.

Recently, Mohammed started working part-time for Lime Bike – a role that allows him to work independently. So far, he is enjoying the job, as it aligns well with his personal preferences.
